PRESIDENT'S REPORT

After 2 years as President of the South Australian Athletic League I would like to say thank you to all members of this great organisation for your on-going support and in particular for your passion for the sport of athletics.

Two years ago, our committee made a promise to you that we would get better at everything we do. I am pleased to say that whilst we have a way to go, we believe that we have made great progress.

- We have brought stability to our Athletics carnival operations. In 2023/24 we were able to put out a schedule well in advance of the season opening.
- We have cleaned up many of our systems. Those relating to handicapping have been improved and simplified and our general business operating systems have been simplified and documented.
- Our finances are now in good shape we have once again made a profit notwithstanding the fact that we have purchased new equipment and paid for much needed system upgrades.
- Our carnivals have been well run.
- We have continued to enhance the Bay Sheffield as South Australia premier footrace.
- We have secured many grants from Local and State Government.
- Our social media presence is outstanding and is recognised nationally.

It is also true that we still have a way to go to get our sport to where it belongs:

- We have some continuing cultural issues that rear their head in terms of behavior.
- The number of athletes is not increasing and needs attention.
- The understanding of the handicapping system is poor and needs better explaining.
- Our technology needs upgrading

In season 2024/25 you will see us put an enormous amount of energy into these areas:

As well as taking the Bay Sheffield to a new level (we are working on this now) we will:

- Embark on an ambitious recruiting campaign leaving no stone unturned to secure more athletes across all categories.
- Provide increased education around the systems that we use.
- Be much stricter on behavioral issues as they arise.
- Ramp up our sponsorship levels.
- Develop our volunteer base so that we have less reliance on too few.

In any leadership position, it's important to assess, improve, prepare, react and to listen; we can always do things better. We must be open to ideas and constructive suggestions, but we must also remember that the league is run by volunteers, who I believe always do their best. The committee might not get everything right, but overall, I think we've done overwhelmingly positive things.

I would like to thank the committee for their outstanding contribution. Together they have taken the hard yards over the first two years. I would like to particularly thank outgoing members Gordon Brimble and Lisa Boyce whose advice, support and wise counsel has been outstanding.

It is also important to acknowledge the important work of our Executive Officer Jenny Poole. Jenny is the league's number one supporter and advocate and dedicates so much to our organisation well in excess of the hours she is paid for. Jenny, you are an invaluable resource.

It is also critical that we acknowledge our volunteers. They turn up each week and do a magnificent job whether that be in color tent, at the starting and finishing line, packing up and moving trailers without you we would not exist.

Over the last two years, we've developed wonderful relationships with Local and State government and other business organisations. Particular thanks go to Premier Peter Malinauskas, the Sports Minister Katrine Hildyard and the local councils that provide us with invaluable support.

I am proud that the SAAL goes above and beyond to support its members, as well as making sure we give great value back to you. We are not just an athletics organisation we are a whole lot more than that, with great friendships and support networks developed because of our mutual participation in this sport.

The SAAL will continue to build on a foundation of inclusiveness and progressive attitudes, but change is sometimes hard and takes time to adapt to. As a committee, we will not be afraid of healthy, robust conversations or debates, and with such a solid representation across demographics, most perspectives are expressed.

As a committee, I hope all members agree that we've been open to feedback, conversations and ideas, and we hold the interests of the SAAL at the core of any decisions. I believe we acknowledge and respect the history of the SAAL, and that the committee represents members and runs the club for the benefit of all.

We look forward to the coming season.

Notes to the Financial Statements

For the year ended 30 April 2024

1 Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Basis of preparation

This financial report is a special purpose report prepared for distribution to members in order to satisfy the financial reporting requirements of the Associations Incorporations Act (SA) 1985. The committee has determined that the South Australian Athletics League Inc ('the League') is not a reporting entity.

The financial report has been prepared on an accrual basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values or, except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following significant accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report.

(b) Income Tax

The League is exempt from Income Tax under section 23g(iii) of the Income Tax Assessment Act

(c) Revenue and other income

Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable after. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue. Grant and donation revenue is recognised when the League obtains control over the funds. All revenue is stated net of the amount of goods and services tax (GST)

(d) Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include cash on hand, deposits held at call with banks, other short term highly liquid investments with original maturities up to 12 months.

(e) Inventories

Inventories are valued at lower of cost and net realisable value.

(f) Property, plant and equipment

The depreciable amount of all property, plant and equipment is depreciated over the useful lives of the assets to the association commencing from the time the asset is held ready for use.

(g) Employee benefits

Provision is made for the League's liability for employee benefits arising from services rendered by employees to the end of the reporting year. Employee benefits have been measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liability is settled.

(h) Goods and services tax (GST)

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of GST, except where the amount of GST incurred is not recoverable from the Australian Tax Office. In these circumstances the GST is recognised as part of the cost of acquisition of the asset or as part of an item of expense. Receivables and payables in the assets and liabilities statement are shown inclusive of GST
