In the restart athlete Lewis Day appeared to break but it was declared by the Chief Starter a non-start due to the starting gun not firing correctly. No penalty was applied (announced also by race caller Terry McAuliffe after heat). • 70 Metres Women: Heat 2 – Athlete Imogen Nobbs was spoken to by both Chief Steward and Phil Daws about running her races out. Stewards explained not to pull-up before the finish or could be penalised in future.
