ADDENDUM

Notification of Inappropriate behaviour from an Assistant Coach - Anne Marie Mouri Nkeng

On Saturday, 25 November 2023, Anne Marie, without prior permission from Chief Steward/Stewards, entered the judges' tent area to sight the photo finish of the 70m Mens final.

As the Judges had not made their final decision, Anne Marie was asked to move away from the judges' tent area. The decision was confirmed, and Anne Marie viewed the result. She then proceeded to dispute the Judges' decision in an improper and insulting manner.

As a result of this behaviour, a discussion between Anne Marie, Club Coach Luke Hildyard, Chief Steward Trevor Mules and Steward Phil Daws took place. The Chief Steward and Steward conferred and decided that a one (1) week carnival suspension would be imposed should this behaviour recur. Both Anne Marie and Luke Hildyard were informed of the decision.
